## February Mandala Square! Part 4.



R16. Start in the middle ch in a corner with *1hdc-2ch-1hdc, 36 Bp hic, 1 Bp sc around the 2nd puff from round 13. skip 1 st, 2 Bp hdc, 1 Bp sc around the next puff from round 13 , skip $1 \mathrm{st}, 36 \mathrm{Bp}$ hd, around next corner Ch 2 you crochet*( $4 \times 1$ hdc-2ch-1hdc = corner, 296 bp hoc, 8 bp sc)

> R17. Start in a corner with *1sc-2c h-1sc. * *2ch, skip 1 stitch, $1 \mathrm{Fp} s c^{* *}$ repeat until the next corner. * As you see you ended rounds with 1 Fp sc in the last stitch before the corner, you have $39 \times 2 \mathrm{ch}$ in each side.
> $(4 \times 1 \mathrm{sc}-2 \mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{ch}=$ Corner, $156 \mathrm{ch} 2,156 \mathrm{Fp} \mathrm{sc})$

R18. Start in the ch space in a corner with *4dc-2ch-4dc* Skip **1sc, 2ch,1sc. 5 dc In the Ch space** repeat 18 more times. Skip $2 \mathrm{sc}^{*}$ ( $4 \times 4 \mathrm{dc}-2 \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{dc}=$ corner. 380 dc )

R19. Start in the ch2 space in a corner from round 15 with, *3dc together-3ch-1sl st-3ch-2dc together-3ch-1sl st-3ch-3dc together. continue with 1sc in the ch2 space from round 17 directly after 4dc in a corner. **5 Bp hdc, 1sc in the ch 2 space from round 17** Repeat a total of 19 times. Continue in the ch2 space from round 15* Finish this round with 1sl st in 3dc together. $(4 \times 3 \mathrm{dc}$ together-3ch-1slcst-3ch-2dc together-3ch-1sl st-3ch-3dc together $=$ corner, $4 \times 20 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \times 95 \mathrm{Bp}$ hdc)


R20. start in the Ch2 space in a corner from round 18, *2sc-2ch-2sc. 4 Bp hdc, skip 1 stitch, $2 s \mathrm{st}$, 1sl st-2ch-1sl st in the next stitch, ${ }^{* * 5} 5 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st-2ch-1sl st in the next stitch** Repeat 17 more times. 2sl st, skip 1 stitch, $4 \mathrm{Bp} h d{ }^{*}$ ( $4 \times 2 \mathrm{sc}-2 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sc}, 32 \mathrm{Bph} \mathrm{hd}, 528 \mathrm{sl}$ st, $76 \times 2 \mathrm{ch}$ )


Now we're done, right?
I have chosen to continue to get a back to a pillow.
To get a back cover I have chosen to start crocheting on the wrong side of the work and in the stitches from V16.

I will come back to you with description!
The dimension of our February Mandala Square is about 48 cm , but it is possible to block to about 50 cm .
I have used Catona from Scheepjes and crochet hook 3 for my Square.
