## Yarn: I have used Catona

## Crochet hook: 3

## Size:

Mini 18cm
Medium 32 cm

## Description of stitches and other info:

SI st = Slip stitch
Ch = Chain
$\mathrm{Sc}=$ Single crochet
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half Double Crochet
Fpsc $=$ Front post single crochet
Fphdc = Front post half double crochet
Fpdc = Front post double crochet
Fp3puff = Make a cover and pick up yarn in the same way as you crochet a Fpdc, you do this three times and should now have 7 loops on the hook, make a cover and pull the yarn through 6 loops, make a new cover and pull through the last 2 the loops on the hook.

Fp2puff =Make a cover and pick up yarn in the same way as you crochet a Fpdc, you do this two times and should now have 5 loops on the hook, make a cover and pull the yarn through 4 loops, make a new cover and pull through the last 2 the loops on the hook.
**_** $=$ Repeat the number of times referred to in the pattern
*_* $=$ Repeat the whole round
()$=$ Total number of stitches for finished round

Each round ends with sl st in the 1st st on round.

Start with ch4 and make a loop with 1sl st in the first ch.

R1. 12 Dc in the ch4 loop
R2. Start in the first dc *1Fpdc, 1dc in the space before next dc*
(12 Fpdc, 12 dc )

R3. Start in the first Fpdc *Fp3puff, ch1, 1hdc in the dc, ch1*
(12 Fp3puff, 24 ch1, 12 hdc)
R4. Start in the first Fp3puff *1 Fphdc, ch3, skip ch1, 1 Fphdc, ch3, skip ch1* (24 ch3, 24 Fphdc)

R5. SI st in the ch3 space, *1sc in the ch3 space, ch3, skip Fphdc*
(24 ch3, 24sc)
R6. SI st to the second ch of 3. 2dc together in the following way: First Dc in the second ch of 3 , skip $1 \mathrm{ch}+1 \mathrm{sc}+1 \mathrm{ch}$, in the second ch of 3 you crochet the second dc together with the first dc. ch4. *2dc together in the following way: Crochet the first dc in the same stitch that you crochet the second dc in the previous 2 dc together. Skip 1ch+1sc+1ch, in the second ch of 3 you crochet the second dc together with the first dc. ch4.* The last 2 dc together keep in mind that the second dc is crocheted in the same stitch as the first dc on the round. ( $24 \times 2 \mathrm{dc}$ tog, 24 ch 4 )

R7. SI st in the ch4 space. *7dc in the ch4 space, ch1, skip 2 dc together, 1 sl st in the next ch4 space, ch1, skip 2 dc together*
(12x7dc, 24 ch1, 12sl st)
R8. SI st in the space between 1:st and 2:nd dc of 7. *1 hdc in the space between 1:st and 2:nd dc. **1Fpdc in the dc, 1 hdc in the space before next dc** a total of 5 times. 2Fpdc together in the next 2 dc , skipping ch1-SI st-ch1* ( $72 \mathrm{hdc}, 12 \times 2$ Fpdc together, 60 Fpdc )

R9. SI st to the first Fpdc, *** 1 Fp2puff in the Fpdc, 1 hdc** a total of 4 times. 1 Fp2puff in the last Fpdc. Skip hdc 1 Fpsc in the 2 Fpdc together, skip hdc*
( 60 Fp2puff, 12 Fpsc, 48hdc)

## If you want to stop here, crochet the following as a final round. Otherwise, continue with Round 10.

SI st to the second Fp2puff, * 1Fpsc in the Fp2puff, ch3, skip hdc, crochet Fpsc-ch4-Fpsc in the next Fp2puff. ch3, skip hdc, 1 Fpsc, ch3, 2Fpsc together in the next two Fp2puff, ch3*

R10. SI st to the second Fp2puff. *1 Fphdc in the Fp2puff. ** ch3, skip hdc, 1 Fphdc in the Fp2puff** a total of 2 times. ch3, skip hdc, 2 Fphdc together in the next 2 Fphdc. ch3, skip hdc*

R11. SI st in the ch3 space, * **1sc in the ch 3 space, ch4, skip Fphdc** 2 times, 1 sc in the ch 3 space, ch4, 1sc in Fphdc together, ch4, skip Fphdc* (48sc, 48 ch 4 )

R12 \& R13. SI st in the ch4 space, *1sc in the ch4 space, ch4, skip 1sc*
(48sc, 48 ch 4 )
R14. SI st to the second ch of 4. 2dc together in the following way: First Dc in the second ch of 4 , skip $2 \mathrm{ch}+1 \mathrm{sc}+1 \mathrm{ch}$, in the second ch of 4 you crochet the second dc together with the first dc. ch4. *2dc together in the following way: Crochet the first dc in the same stitch that you crochet the second dc in the previous 2 dc together. Skip $2 \mathrm{ch}+1 \mathrm{sc}+1 \mathrm{ch}$, in the second ch of 4 you crochet the second dc together with the first dc. ch4.* The last 2 dc together keep in mind that the second dc is crocheted in the same stitch as the first dc on the round. ( $48 \times 2 \mathrm{dc}$ together. 48 ch 4 )

R15. SI st in the ch4 space. *7dc in the ch4 space, ch1, skip 2 dc together, 1 sl st in the next ch4 space, ch1, skip 2 dc together* ( $24 \times 7 \mathrm{dc}, 48 \mathrm{ch} 1,24 \mathrm{sl}$ st)

R16. SI st in the space between 1:st and 2:nd dc of 7 . *1 hdc in the space between 1:st and 2:nd dc. **1Fpdc in the dc, 1 hdc in the space before next dc** a total of 5 times. 2Fpdc together in the next 2 dc , skipping ch1-Slst-ch1*
(144 hdc, 120 Fpdc, 24 2Fpdc together)
R17. SI st to the first Fpdc, *** 1 Fp2puff in the Fpdc, 1hdc** a total of 4 times. 1 Fp2puff in the last Fpdc. Skip hdc 1 Fpsc in the 2 Fpdc together, skip hdc*
(120 Fp2puff, 96 hdc, 24 Fpsc).

## The final Round!

SI st to the second Fp2puff, * 1Fpsc in the Fp2puff, ch3, skip hdc, crochet Fpsc-ch4-Fpsc in the next Fp2puff. ch3, skip hdc, 1 Fpsc, ch3, 2Fpsc together in the next two Fp2puff, ch3, skipping Fpsc*
(96 Fpsc, 24 2Fpsc together, 24 ch4, 96 ch3).
