Yarn: I have chosen Tilda (540 Powder Pink) for my one color and the consumption was 50 grams.

Little one color is in Catona (105 Bridal White)

My big multicolored is crocheted in Catona.

Color 1 - 172 Light Silver

Color 2 - 105 Bridal White

Color 3 - 110 Jet Black

Color 4 - 242 Metal Gray

Color 5 - 408 Old Rose

Crochet Hook: 3

Size: 16cm / 32 cm

Mask description & other information:

Ch - Chain

Sl st - Slip stitch

Sc - Single crochet

Hdc - Half double crochet

Dc - Double crochet

2dccl - 2 double crochet worked together in the same space.

Dc3tog - Double crochet worked 3 together

Hdc2tog - Half double crochet worked 2 together

Puff= do the following 4 times - yarn over, insert the hook in the specified stitch.

You now have 9 loops in total on the hook. Pick up yarn and pull through all loops, lock puff with 1 ch.

Picot - ch3, 1 sl st in the first ch.

 $*_*$ = Repeat the whole round

() = Total number of stitches for finished round

Each round ends with sl st in the 1st st on round.

Note that the pattern is written for one color, but of course you can vary your colors. Then think about which stitch you should start the round.

At each round I have noted the color if you choose to make a multicolored mandala.

I have not blocked my mandalas, I used my iron and pressed them.

(Color 1)
R1.Start with ch5 and make a loop with 1sl st in the first ch.
1sl st + 16 dc in the ch5 space.
(16dc)
(Color 1)
R2. *Dc3tog, crochet as follows: Ist dc in one dc from previous round, 2nd dc in the space before
next dc, 3rd dc in 2nd dc from previous round. ch4*
(8 Dc3tog. 8 ch4)
(Color 2)
R3. 1 sl st in the ch4 space. *6dc in the ch4 space, skip Dc3tog*
(48 dc)
(Color 2)
R4. *Dc3tog crochet as follows: 1st dc in one dc from previous round, 2nd dc in the space before next
dc, 3rd dc in 2nd dc from previous round. ch3*
(24 Dc3tog, 24 ch3)
(Color 3)
R5. 1 sl st in the ch3 space, *3sc in the ch3 space, skip Dc3tog*
(72sc)
(Color 1)
R6. Crochet in the back loop only.
*1sc in each stitch*
(72 \text{ sc})
(Color 4)
R7. *2dccl - ch2 - 2 dccl in the same stitch, skip 2 stitches*
(24 ch2, 48 x 2dccl)
(Color 5)
R8. Sl st in the ch2 space, * 1 puff in the ch2 space, ch3, skip 2dccl, 1 sl st in the space before the next
2dccl, ch3, skip 2 dccl*
(24 puff, 24 sl st, 48 ch3)
(Color 3)
R9. Ch1, *1sc in the puff, ch5, continue in the next puff*
(24 sc, 24 ch5)
```

If you choose to finish here, you now crochet Round 22 as a finish.

R10. 1 sl st in the ch5 space, *4sc in the ch5 space. Hdc2tog, crochet as follows: 1st hdc in the ch 5
space, skip sc, 2nd hdc in the next ch5 space.*
(96 sc, 24 Hdc2tog)
(Color 1)
R11. Crochet in the back loop only.
*1sc in each stitch*
(120sc)
(Color 1)
R12. 1 sl st, *1sc, ch3, skip next stitch*
(60sc, 60 ch3)
(Color 1)
R13. 1sl st in the ch3 space, *1sc in the ch3 space, ch3, skip 1sc*
(60 sc, 60 ch3)
(Color 1)
R14. Repeat R13.
(60sc, 60 ch3)
(Color 3)
R15. Sl st in the ch3 space, *3sc in the ch3 space, skip 1sc*
(180 sc)
(Color 2)
V16. Crochet in the back loop only.
*1sc in each stitch*
(180sc)
(Color 2)
R17. *3dccl, ch3*
(60 3dccl, 60 ch3)
(Color 3)
R18. S1 st in the ch3 space, *3sc in the ch3 space, skip 3 dccl*
(180 sc)
(Färg 1)
V19. Crochet in the back loop only.
*1sc in each stitch*
(180sc)

(Color 4)

R20. *2dccl-ch2-2dccl in the same stitch, skip 2 stitches* (60 ch2, 120 Dc2tog)

(Color 5)

R21. Sl st in the ch2 space, * 1 puff in the ch2 space, ch3, skip 2dccl, 1 sl st in the space before the next 2dccl, ch3, skip 2 dccl* (60 puff, 120 ch3, 60sl st)

(Color 5)

R22. 1 sc in the puff, ch1, 1picot, ch1, continue in the next puff* (60 picot, 60 sc, 120 ch1)
