

New Cornflower By Ella



Description of stitches and other information

Ch = Chain

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sc = Singel crochet

Hdc = Hald double crochet

Dc = Double crochet

Fpdc = Front post double crochet

Fptr = Front post treble crochet

Bphdc = Back post double crochet

Popcorn = Crocheted with 4 double crochets in the same stitch

** _ ** Crochet the number of times indicated on the row.

* _ * = Repeat the entire round

Finish all rounds with 1 sl st in the 1st stitch on the round.

If you crochet all rounds with the same yarn, crochet sl st until the indicated stitch.

I have used Scheepjes Whirl no 555 and crocheted from the middle, I have used about 500 meters.

Crochet hook: 3

Size: 50-55cm

R1. Start with ch5 which ends in a ch-ring with 1 sl st in 1st ch.

Crochet 16dc around the ch-ring

R2. Ch3 = first dc, 1dc in the space before next dc, *1dc in the dc, 1dc in the space before next dc*

R3. 1sl st, *1 Fpdc in the dc from previous round = *dc that you crocheted in the space between 2 dc.*

1 Fpdc in the dc from round 1, you skip 1dc from last round = *dc which is hidden behind Fpdc**

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

R4. *Crochet behind R3 and in the stitches from R2.*

1 dc in each stitch.

R5. Ch2 = first hdc, work 1 more dc in the same stitch. *1hdc, 2hdc in the next stitch*

R6. Ch1, 2sc, *1Fptr in the Fpdc from round 3, 3sc (*1st sc becomes in the hidden stitch behind the Fptr*)

After the last Fptr work 1sc.

R7. Ch2 = first hdc, 1hdc in each stitch.

R8. Ch1, 1sc in each stitch.

R9. Ch1, 1sc, 2 Fptr together as follows, **crochet in Fptr from V6**: 1st Fptr to the left and 2nd Fptr in the Fptr to the right. *4 sc, first sc is crocheted behind 2 Fptr together. 2 Fptr together as follows, **crochet in Fptr from V6**: 1st Fptr to the left and 2nd Fptr in the Fptr to the right* Finish with 3 sc.

R10. Ch1, 1sc. 1Fphdc in the 2 Fptr together. *4sc, 1 Fphdc in the 2 Fptr together* Finish with 2sc.



R11. Ch3 = first dc, crochet 1 more dc in the same stitch. *1Fpdc in the Fphdc from previous round. 2dc, 1 popcorn, 2 dc in the same stitch*

R12. 1 Fpdc in each stitch from previous round.

R13. 3 sl st, * crochet the following in the same stitch: **1st-1ch** a total of 5 times, crochet one more dc in the same stitch. Skip 2 stitches, 1 Fpsc in the next stitch, skip 2 stitches*

R14. Sl st in the ch1 space * **3hdc in the ch1 space, 1 Fpsc in the dc** a total of 2 times, in the next ch1 space work 2dc-ch2-2dc, **1 Fpsc in the dc, hdc in the ch1 space** a total of 2 times. Skip last dc, 1 Fpsc in the Fpsc from previous round. Skip next stitch*



R15 – R20 crocheted from the back of the work.

R15. The round is crocheted in the front loop of R11.

Ch3 = first dc, continue with 1dc in each stitch.

R16. Ch2 = first hdc, continue with 1hdc in each stitch from previous round.

R17. Ch1, 1sc in each stitch from previous round.

R18. Ch3 = first dc, 1dc in each stitch from previous round. .

R19. Ch2 = first hdc, in the next stitch crochet 2hdc, *1hdc, 2hdc in the next stitch*

R20. Ch1, 1sc in each stitch from previous round. Cut the yarn and fasten off.



Turn your work and continue crocheting from the right side.

R21. We will now also crochet in the "top" from R14. Between each "top" there should be 9 stitches. To mark where we start crocheting on this round, lay out the work and draw a "top" towards R20. Start with a Sc in stitch from R20 with "top" pointing towards. 1 sc in ch2 on the "top". 9sc, 1sc in the next "top". After the last "top", crochet 8 sc.

R22. Ch2 = 1hdc, 1Fpdc in the sc that has been crocheted in the "top". *9hdc, 1Fpdc in the sc that has been crocheted in the "top"* Finish with 8 hdc.

R23. 1 Bpsc in each stitch from previous round.

R24. 1 popcorn, *2dc, 1popcorn* after the las popcorn work 3dc.

R25. 1 Fpdc in each stitch from previous round.

R26. 1 Bpsc in each stitch from previous round

R27. Ch3 = 1 dc, ch1, crochet 1dc in the stitch before the stitch you made first dc. * Skip 1 stitch, 1dc, ch1, 1dc in the stitch you skipped*

R28. 1sl st in the ch1 space, *2hdc in the ch1 space, skip 2dc, 3hdc in the next ch1 space, skip 2dc*

R29. 1 Bphdc in each stitch from previous round.

R30. 1 Fphdc in each stitch from previous round.

R31. 3 sl st, * crochet the following in the same stitch: **1st-1ch** a total of 5 times, crochet one more dc in the same stitch. Skip 2 stitches, 1 Fpsc in the next stitch, skip 2 stitches* after the last repetition you have 3 stitches left, skip them and end it up with 1sc in the first dc on the round.

R32. Sl st in the ch1 space * **3hdc in the ch1 space, 1 Fpsc in the dc** a total of 2 times, in the next ch1 space work 2dc-ch2-2dc, **1 Fpsc in the dc, hdc in the ch1 space** a total of 2 times. Skip last dc, 1 Fpsc in the Fpsc from previous round. Skip next stitch* Cut the yarn.



Round 33 – 38 crocheted from the back of the work.

R33. The round is crocheted in the front loop of R29.

Ch3 = first dc, continue with 1dc in each stitch.

R34. Ch2 = 1hdc, 1hdc in each stitch from previous round.

R35. Ch1, 1sc in each stitch from previous round.

R36. Ch3 = 1dc, 1dc in each stitch from previous round.

R37. Ch2 = 1hdc, 1hdc in each stitch from previous round.

R38. Ch1, 1sc in each stitch from previous round, cut the yarn.

Turn your work and continue crocheting from the right side.

R39. We will now also crochet in the "top" from R32. Between each "top" there should be 6 stitches. To mark where we start crocheting on this round, lay out the work and draw a "top" towards R38. Start with a Sc in stitch from R38 with "top" pointing towards. 1 sc in ch2 on the "top". *6sc first sc of 6 is done in the stitch that is hidden behind "top"*, 1sc in the next "top". After the last "top", crochet 5 sc. The work can be experienced as wavy but straightens out in the coming rounds.

R40. Ch2 = 1hdc, 1Fpdc in the sc that has been crocheted in the "top". *6hdc, 1Fpdc in the sc that has been crocheted in the "top"* Finish with 5 hdc.

R41. 1 Bpsc in each stitch from previous round.

R42. 1 popcon, *2dc, 1 popcorn*

R43. 1 Fpdc in each stitch from previous round.

R44. 1 Bpsc in each stitch from previous round.

R45. Ch3 = 1 dc, ch1, crochet 1dc in the stitch before the stitch you made first dc. * Skip 1 stitch, 1dc, ch1, 1dc in the stitch you skipped* Finish by skipping the last stitch.

R46. 1sl st in the ch1 space, * **3hdc in the ch1 space, skip 2dc** a total of 37 times, in the next ch1 space you crocheted 2hdc, skip 2dc* crochet * _ * a total of 3 times, finish with 3hdc in the last ch1 space.

R47. 1 Bphdc in each stitch from previous round.

R48. 1 Fphdc in each stitch from previous round.

R49. Ch3 = first dc, crochet the following in the same stitch: ****1st-1ch**** a total of 5 times, crochet one more dc in the same stitch. Skip 2 stitches, 1 Fpsc in the next stitch, skip 2 stitches. * in the next stich crochet the following: ****1st-1ch**** a total of 5 times, crochet one more dc in the same stitch. Skip 2 stitches, 1 Fpsc in the next stitch, skip 2 stitches. *

R50. Sl st in the ch1 space * ****3hdc in the ch1 space, 1 Fpsc in the dc**** a total of 2 times, in the nexg ch1 space work 2dc-ch2-2dc, ****1 Fpsc in the dc, hdc in the ch1 space**** a total of 2 times. Skip last dc, 1 Fpsc in the Fpsc from previous round. Skip next stitch* Cut the yarn.

Important to block your work for best results. (a better picture of the finished result will come later)

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
